Goals:

1. Learn educational strategies for use in teaching patients, families, medical personnel or the public.
 - a. Learning theories
 - b. Resources available
 - c. Address particular topics of likely use in the future.
2. Learn educational strategies for use in improving the resident's own learning and test taking skills.
 - a. Resources available
 - b. Practice test taking strategies
 - c. Time management for studying

1. 2 or 4 week reading elective - utilizing Learning Resource Center
2. Resident may not do more than 4 weeks total of reading electives during residency
3. Prior to beginning this elective, the resident must either have completed all 4 month long electives or have a plan in place for this to be accomplished.
4. Resident to coordinate scheduling with Joanna Arnold
5. Resident to develop individual objectives prior to start of rotation
6. Resident to meet with Joanna to develop plan to address objectives
 - a. Robyn will be available to assist in identifying learning materials
7. Resident to document achievement of these objectives at completion of rotation (i.e. patient education project, list of resources, documentation of study time, presentation @ Wednesday conference)
8. Resident to meet with Robyn at completion of elective for evaluation
